Gaela, Linda, Denise, and Theresa all live together in a highly active household. When they moved in with each other, these ladies and the Emmaus team members who support them quickly bonded over their similar interests. Forever friendships were made in minutes.

The friends enjoy crafting, artwork, playing games, doing puzzles, helping to cook dinner, watching movies, listening to music, and going shopping at local stores across their community.

When they wake up in the morning, Gaela, Linda, Denise, and Terri all enjoy starting their day off with a warm cup of coffee. Over their morning treat, they talk to each other about what they want to do so they can prepare for the spirited day ahead of them.



With assistance from Emmaus Direct Support Professionals, they often develop a busy schedule. They like to keep the home organized so that the women are ready for anything.

Gaela loves to craft and create beautiful artwork. When Gaela is in her artistic mood, she will let someone know so they can set up her art station. It takes only a breath of fresh air or beautiful sunlight to inspire Gaela.

So, when the weather is nice, you will often find her coloring in one of her favorite spots: her home's sunroom. One of Gaela's goals is to clean up her art station when she is finished creating. With hard work, she can now complete this task with limited assistance!

Terri is a fashionista! She loves keeping up with current trends and looks forward to picking out her outfit each day. She spends her free time getting her nails done, doing her hair, and getting dressed up.

Emmaus Direct Support Professionals will support Terri with these activities whenever she needs a helping hand. Terri is working towards keeping her closet organized, so her favorite styles are always easy to find.

When Linda has free time at home, she relaxes while watching television. One of Linda's favorite channels is the "True Oldies Channel," which hosts her favorite shows like Full House or Leave it to Beaver.

Whether it is a game, an enjoyable read, or a video, Linda also enjoys spending time in apps on her tablet. The Emmaus team works closely with Linda, and she is quickly learning how to do many of these activities independently.

Denise has a true artist's soul. She is retired but has dreams of selling her art. In fact, when the women threw a housewarming party,



Denise created several pieces of art as thank-you gifts for the people who made the new home possible. With a nickname like "Picasso" you can only imagine the limitless creativity that comes from Denise on a daily basis.

Jessica Stevenson is an Emmaus Direct Support Professional who has been working with Gaela, Terri, Denise, and Linda for over three years now.

"I love assisting these ladies with 'their walk of life.'" says Jessica. "It means a lot to me to be there for them, forming companionship and making sure they are in good health."

Sharing a new place with others may seem daunting at the start. However, with close friends at your side and the support of a team who will help you reach your goals, **anything is possible.**

The Story Behind Emmaus' Surprise

TRANSFORMATIONAL

Estate Gift...

Charlie and Mae Silverberg embody the truism that people support what they know and love. The Silverbergs were long-time donors to Emmaus. Their passion for Emmaus stemmed from Mae's lifelong membership with the United Church of Christ.

For much of her life, Mae was a member of St. John United Church of Christ, where she also served as the Financial Secretary for more than 35 years.

Former pastor Reverend Ric Zuch fondly remembers her as 'meticulous and professional' in her work managing the church finances. And Rev. Ric shared that he 'learned more about St. John' from her than she did from him.

St. John UCC has supported Emmaus for decades --- through both their annual donations and volunteer efforts. So, it came as no surprise that Mae also began volunteering at Emmaus.

Mae and her friends were known as the 'mail ladies'- volunteers we could count on to help us prepare our mail campaigns.

However, what was a surprise, until very recently, is just how much of an impact Mae would have at Emmaus.

In 2010, Mrs. Silverberg was hospitalized unexpectedly and although she remained active for many more years, she was never able to return to her home and live independently as she had hoped.

As her health continued to decline, Mae reached out to her longtime friend and power of attorney, Julie Rhodes, to help manage her financial affairs.

Through Julie, Mae let Emmaus know of her intent to donate her home to Emmaus as part of her estate. As there was no reason not to put her home to use immediately, Mae made her vacant house available to Emmaus for our clients while she was still living.

"We are so grateful to have a home like this for our clients," says Lisa Key, Chief Development Officer at Emmaus. "The house is in a beautiful neighborhood and

is absolutely lovely inside and out."

Emmaus called on volunteers to help with 'moving day.' With guidance from Julie, Emmaus staff and volunteers packed Mae's belongings.

We even hosted an event that allowed clients and employees to select items they could use both in this home and in other client homes.

With the home now empty, modifications were necessary before our clients moved in. (Please see the next article which details the many organizations who made this possible.)

The Emmaus facilities team worked to modify her home to make it fully accessible. New flooring, roll-in showers, and widened doorways would be necessary.

The team also devised a plan to convert the three-bedroom home into a four-bedroom by transforming a formal sitting room into a bedroom.





The home also required new attic insulation, a retaining wall, and an interior makeover to open the floor plan.

These renovations were made possible through generous support from our community.

After more than a year of work, the home was ready for Terri, Gaela, Linda, and Denise to move in. These women had previously lived in a different home together and were excited about their new home.

Faith is an important part of these women's lives, so our spiritual care team hosted a "blessing of the home" to dedicate the new space.

Sadly, Mrs. Silverberg passed away in July of 2020. We are grateful that she knew her

house had created a warm, safe, welcoming home for our clients. Through the entire process, Julie Rhodes guided Mae and Emmaus through this unique philanthropic project.

In the summer of 2020, Julie shared even more unbelievable news with us. Not only had Mae donated her beautiful home to Emmaus but had also designated an estate gift valued at more than \$2,500,000!

This incredible donation will be placed in our endowment to ensure the continued support of our clients.

We are amazed by this extraordinary gift and incredibly grateful for the Silverbergs' generosity. Their legacy gift will not only help pay for the long-term upkeep of the home they

loved so dearly but will also help to sustain the services our clients need.

Much like many lifelong donors, Mae's support of our mission and ministry stemmed from her membership with the United Church of Christ.

She volunteered her time, getting to know the men and women we serve. And she gave generously out of her own blessings.

With every meal that the Emmaus staff cook, with every trip we provide, and with every new skill that we teach, she is present.

Mae's spirit truly lives on through the ***Spirited People Leading Spirited Lives*** at Emmaus.

IT TAKES A VILLAGE

They say, "It takes a village," and that could not be more true at Emmaus. The renovation of the Silverberg home is a beautiful example of the community connecting with the expertise at Emmaus to create something special.

At Emmaus, it's not just about the house, though accessible housing is critical to our mission. It's also about the environment we create in the house to make it a home.

Emmaus Direct Support Professionals provide personalized support and help facilitate a family atmosphere. People's lives are changed.

None of that is possible without the resources to serve our clients. The Silverberg home renovation could not have been possible without volunteers and financial gifts from the community.

During the renovation, Employees from **Edward Jones** arrived on the scene to help with packing up the home. **MasterCard** employees refreshed the yard and did some light demolition.

The youth group from **Peace United Church of Christ** from

Rochester, MN cleared away yard debris and tidied the home's exterior. **Restore St. Charles**, a loyal monthly volunteer group, painted the interior of the home.

The project not only involved sweat equity, but it also required financial resources. The **City Council of St. Charles** granted funds through the Public Health, Safety, and Wellness of Residents program. This grant allowed Emmaus to replace the attic insulation.

The St. Louis Home Builders Association Charitable Foundation gave towards new toilets and fixtures, window treatments, flooring, and the construction of a fourth bedroom.

The Schaeffer Foundation helped with costs to replace a retaining wall, haul away construction debris, install flooring. Their gift funded a myriad of supplies needed for our in-house facilities team to complete the work.

Our world feels so divided, but in this case, the local government, private donors, companies, and faith communities all came together with one common goal: to take that which was no longer

useful and make it a home for those in our community who have a true need.

In turn, the women who now live in this home add their gifts into the community. The women attend worship services, shop in the local stores, and add to the neighborhood's diversity. They have created and sold artwork. They have expanded their social circle and made new friends.

After moving into their new home, the housemates hosted a small get-together at their home to thank the people who had made the project possible.

As the women, their friends and family, new neighbors, donors, volunteers, and the Emmaus team gathered around their kitchen table that evening, we were the very definition of a village.
