# Restore St. Charles

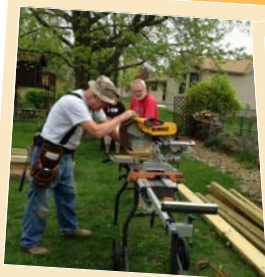


We would like to thank all our volunteers for their dedication, contribution, and support for the women and men of Emmaus over the years! At Emmaus, we have over 60 homes across four different counties, so we rely on volunteers to lend a helping hand. Emmaus has a diverse group of volunteers, including groups from out of state, youth groups, students, churches, and local business personnel. While we have a wide array of volunteers, one group that has consistently volunteered with Emmaus since January 2010: Restore St. Charles.

# TECH 4 INDEPENDENCE

iPads. Crossfit. TikTok. Amazon. What do they all have in common? In a recent partnership between Emmaus and The Adam Morgan Foundation, technology is promoting self-confidence, self-reliance, love of learning, and independence. Over the past year, people like Jimmy, Danny, Sean, Colin, Pat, and others engaged with the *Technology 4 Independence* pilot program, where they discovered a variety of new things.

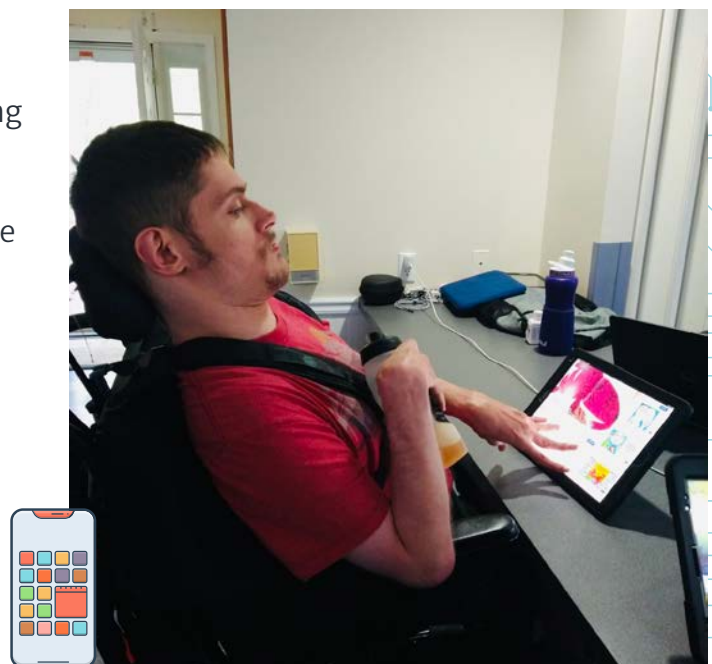
As the process began, two focus areas needed to be addressed before any technology could be introduced:

1. How self-directed the clients and staff were in their own learning.
2. The current beliefs, values, and attitudes of staff towards their clients' abilities were.

"Technology is an amazing tool that can enhance anyone's life; however, you must engage actively with the tools for it to be effective. Many times, there is a lack of belief in oneself or from staff when it comes to a person with disabilities. Looking at the current mindset of both the clients and staff were at the core of introducing and maintaining technology as an effective tool in building self-confidence, self-determination, and increased independence." Rachel Morgan, CEO of The Adam Morgan Foundation.

After completing a pre-assessment and crafting meaningful and positive goals, the program supported Emmaus team members and clients to revisit their relationships. The goal was higher expectations and trust that their clients can make their own decisions and engage at a higher level with technology. The participants have seen multiple examples of growth.

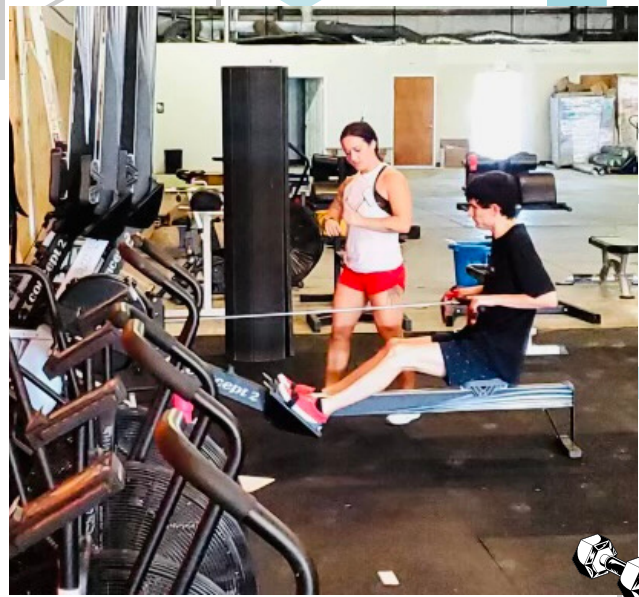
Jimmy can verbally speak some words but isn't always understood. The Technology 4 Independence Program equipped him with an iPad and explored apps like App2Speak. These tools teach Jimmy and DSPs how to communicate what Jimmy wants or feels. Jimmy can now tell his staff at home and people in the community a lot more than he is used to, and he is learning more every day. He reflects on how this program has helped him grow in deeper relationships to his Direct Support Professional and looks forward to learning new things alongside them.





Danny wanted to have more control of his body. Thanks to the Technology 4 Independence program, he can finally type what he is feeling and communicate his needs in a way that makes him feel comfortable with his support team. Since tech training started, he is now going to CrossFit and using his iPad to communicate with his fitness coach. Danny says, "This has changed everything for me. I feel happier, and I like that people hear me. I am hopeful they will continue to help me; my staff and others learn together so I can be heard. I have only just begun to tell you what I am thinking."

Another example is Sean's confidence after getting that extra push. Sean is pretty tech-savvy, but often kept to himself and used technology for things like watching videos and listening to music. Today, Sean is not the same introverted person. After communicating his wants, he set up a bank account and uses a debit card to purchase things off Amazon. He recently bought his own cell phone and uses it to combine his love for music and social media through TikTok.



"It is so much fun to see Sean light up when talking about things that he has searched. To see the joy in Sean's face when he video chats with his family and friends is what this is all about. It makes staff smile from ear-to-ear to see how much happiness technology has brought to Sean and the team's life."

In the digital world, Sean can express himself in ways he never knew existed. His stardom has even landed him a few dates.

After pilot program, the post-assessment results were undeniable. The current participants are experiencing self-confidence, self-reliance, love of learning, and connection. They are learning through meaningful, real-life situations. Emmaus Direct Support Professionals report gaining new insight into what their clients can do. They gained new communication methods that increased their ability to understand their clients. As a bonus, staff who went through the program increased their own self-confidence and job satisfaction.

Technology is a tool for everyone. The real challenge is looking inside ourselves and challenging our beliefs, values, and attitudes about ourselves and others.



# DIVERSIFY DUCKFEST



Since 2014, Duckfest has proudly partnered with Emmaus Homes to raise both awareness about our mission and funds to benefit our clients. The idea of creating an event like Duckfest can be traced back to former Emmaus Homes board member, Shawn Saale. Shawn and his duck hunting loving friends created the idea of an event that not only showcased the hundreds of duck clubs in our area, but more importantly, raised money to benefit the clients we serve.

Held on Saturday, October 1 at Smartt Field in St. Charles, Duckfest celebrated ALL things outdoors with an emphasis on waterfowl hunting and conservation. Free admission, live music, grand-prize raffles, a variety of vendors, delicious food, and plenty of drinks to go around with a great crowd all combined to make this a fun-filled day for all who attended! The event also included a Duck Calling Contest, drawing competitors from across the region to show their calling prowess.

In 2022, Duckfest expanded their reach to benefit even more local non-profit organizations. Duckfest is proud to continue their partnership with Emmaus but has also included other great charities like Great Rivers Habitat Alliance, the St. Charles Jaycees, and the Joshua Chamberlain Society.

The **Great Rivers Habitat Alliance** (GRHA) was founded in 2000 to combat the growing consumption of the 100-year Confluence Flood Plain through commercial development. Primarily comprised of St. Charles County flood plain landowners, GRHA tackles the policies permitting wholesale flood plain development and encourages thoughtful alternatives. 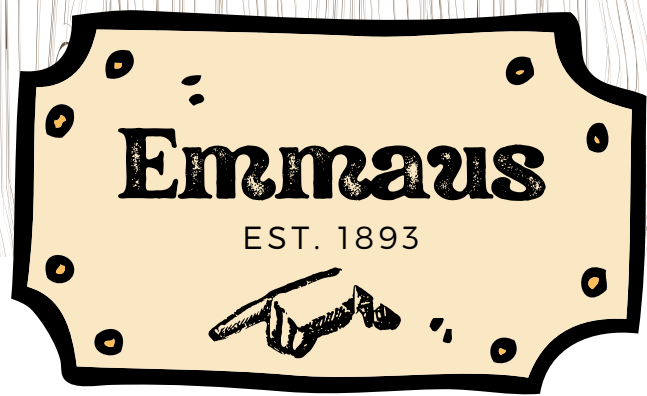

Think about the places where you feel most comfortable and the most like yourself. They are likely the places – and with the people – who know you. We all crave familiarity, and the people of Emmaus are no different.

As Emmaus' spiritual care services continue to evolve, we look to our church partners to invite the people of Emmaus into their midst. If you are local, build a relationship with our folks and invite your new friends to church. No matter where they are located, congregations can think about how to make the church fully inclusive for people with disabilities. Maybe a person with a disability could serve as a deacon or church board member. Maybe they could sing in the choir.

Research shows that about 85% of people visit a church because a friend or relative has invited them. Rev. Andrea Asselmeier says, "It all begins with interacting with people who have different abilities. We can't invite someone if we haven't interacted with them in the first place. What people with developmental disabilities need most is engagement."

Dozens of churches from multiple faith traditions have volunteered, hosted events, and donated to the people of Emmaus. (You can see a list of them in the back of this publication.) One church partner, Grace United Church of Christ in O'Fallon, MO, is leaning into a new era of inclusion.

Grace has hosted several events and invited Emmaus clients as active participants alongside their congregants. Three homes attended their 2022 Easter service and the easter egg hunt afterward. Perhaps most strikingly, when the people of Emmaus walk into Grace UCC, they will see other people with developmental disabilities. Seeing people with diverse abilities assures clients that they are in a place with a track record of inclusion. This can be comforting to a newcomer.

Whether you are near or far, religious or not, we hope you will reach out to people with developmental disabilities in your community to give the greatest gift of all: inclusion.

# COMMUNITY CHAMPS

Emmaus has always championed our clients to be fully included in their communities. It's one thing to say that people with disabilities are welcome in our community. It is another to intentionally create opportunities to support nonprofits and celebrate citizens with disabilities as valued members of the community. Perhaps no municipality in the Emmaus service area embodies this commitment to inclusion more than the City of Saint Charles.

Here are just a few of the ways the City of Saint Charles has enriched the lives of the women and men of Emmaus:

The City Council awarded Emmaus several grants over the years through a program to improve the safety and welfare of citizens. Their grants have funded assistive technology, home renovations, and technology upgrades necessary to deliver services.

For multiple years, the City Arts and Culture Committee funded accessible courses for people with developmental disabilities. Their generosity allowed the students to learn about art, cooking, writing, drama, and cultural traditions. Each semester culminated with a performance or showcase where the students shared their talents with the community.
